Introducing a Worldwide Standard of EP Excellence

Late 2011, the IBHRE will introduce a fourth examination as a new measure of excellence — **the Board Certification Examination for Competency in Cardiac Electrophysiology for the Physician (MD EP)**.

The MD EP exam meets the competency needs of international healthcare systems throughout the globe by bridging the difference between language and practice. This new exam will evaluate knowledge and judgment in the broad domain of clinical cardiac electrophysiology and the diagnosis and treatment of patients who suffer from heart rhythm disorders.

Physicians who qualify may elect to take either of the two exam modules, in addition to a core electrophysiology component: **Adult Electrophysiology** or **Pediatric Electrophysiology**. If you have the training and the experience in EP, now you can also have the credential of Certified Electrophysiology Specialist, Physician (CEPS).
